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Day #1 Friday, September 25, 2009

Depart for picturesque Door County, Wisconsin. Located on a 75 mile peninsula and surrounded by the waters of Green Bay and Lake Michigan, Door County has more than 250 miles of shoreline, with 13 lighthouses and more than 40 islands. Upon our arrival we will visit the Norwegian Stave Kirk at Bjorklunden to learn about the dedication of the family who left this legacy. Koepsel's Farm Market is next to try some of the local produce. We then check into the Wagon Wheel Resort for a two night stay in Ellison Bay, Wisconsin. This evening we have planned a welcome dinner for you at the Mink River Basin. Dinner is included in the cost of the trip.

Day # 2 Saturday, September 26, 2009

Enjoy breakfast at Al Johnson's Swedish Restaurant. Be sure to have your cameras ready! This delightful sod-roofed building comes complete with live goats grazing on the roof. We start the day with a visit to a working apple orchard for a wagon ride tour of the property. Also located on the property is the Orchard County Winery. Here we have a touch of the grape before departing for a tour of the Eagle Bluff Lighthouse. Built in 1868, the Eagle Bluff Lighthouse is one of the 13 lighthouses along the Door County Coast. Lunch in Fish Creek (on your own) and free time in Founders Square for shopping in unique shops and galleries. This evening we will enjoy a genuine Door County Fish Boil at the hotel before heading off to a performance at the Peninsula Players Theatre. Breakfast and dinner are included in the cost of the trip.

Day #3 Sunday, September 27, 2009

Enjoy one last breakfast at the hotel before boarding our motor coach for the trip home. We bid farewell to beautiful Door County and travel back through Wisconsin. Our arrival back in Hiawatha will be late in the afternoon. Breakfast is included in the cost of the trip.
